## ROUTE MAP



### 01 Ha Giang

Jaw-dropping mountain passes and spectacular vistas in Vietnam's northernmost province. Rest at night in friendly ethnic homestays.

### 02 Phong Nha

Home to Son Doong, the world's largest cave, and over 300 others. Find your challenge among wild caves, dense jungle, and underground rivers.

### 03 Da Lat

Rushing waterfalls, glimmering lakes, and rolling pine forests. Test your mettle canyoning at Datanla Falls or camp in the national park.

### 04 Mui Ne

Vietnam's water sports capital. Ride the waves, explore striking sand dunes, and feast on fresh seafood by the shore.

## DAY BY DAY

### D1 Ha Giang

Journey from Hanoi to Ha Giang and spend the night in an ethnic village homestay. Soak up the warm hospitality of your hosts and plan your mountain drive for the next day.



### D2 Ha Giang

Take on the legendary Ma Pi Leng Pass, one of the most dramatic mountain roads in Southeast Asia and descend to the vivid turquoise Nho Que River far below.

### D3 Phong Nha

Return to Hanoi, then fly or take the night bus to Phong Nha Vietnam's Kingdom of Caves, blanketed in thick jungle and carved through with underground rivers.



### D4 Phong Nha

Book a guided cave tour and spend the day exploring the national park. Choose from beginner-friendly caverns to multi-day expeditions deep into the karst wilderness.

### D5 Da Lat

Connect via Ho Chi Minh City and fly to Da Lat. Arrive in time for a warming vegetable hotpot dinner and an evening stroll around the city's scenic Xuan Huong Lake.



### D6 Da Lat

Start the day with a SUP session on the lake at sunrise, then go canyoning down Datanla Falls or take a guided hike through the surrounding pine forests and coffee plantations.

### D7 Mui Ne

Go overland from Da Lat to finish the trip on the beach in Mui Ne. Try kitesurfing or windsurfing, ride a quad bike over the red and white sand dunes, and end with a seafood feast by the water.
