**01 Hanoi**

Vietnam's capital is steeped in history. The Old Quarter's 36 guild streets are the heart of the action. Make time to visit a few excellent museums and witness local life along the lakes.

02 Hoi An

Hoi An's rice paddies and beaches are great for families, with top amusement parks and golf courses in easy reach. See the countryside and Ancient Town by bicycle or by boat.

03 Can Tho

Vietnam's Mekong Delta is full of fun things to see and do, from sampan rides to fruit orchards, garden homestays to floating markets. River cruises make it easy to get from place to place.

04 Phu Quoc

The whole family is bound to love the beaches and water parks on Phu Quoc island. Go snorkelling off the islets, tour bee farms together, and spend sunny days on the sand.

DAY BY DAY

D1 Hanoi

Start the trip with a cyclo ride through the Old Quarter's narrow guild streets, then visit the Vietnam Museum of Ethnology — one of the best museums in Southeast Asia and a favourite with curious kids.

**D2 Hoi An**

Fly down to Hoi An and head straight to An Bang beach, where cool cafes, seafood restaurants, and resorts with wonderful swimming pools make for a perfect family afternoon.

D3 Hoi An

Visit the Ancient Town in the morning, browsing the lantern shops and tailor stalls by bicycle. In the afternoon, head to the nearby amusement parks or take a basket boat ride through the coconut forest.

**D4 Can Tho**

Fly down to Can Tho and settle in along the river. Take an evening sampan cruise to get your bearings on the waterways of the Mekong Delta and watch the river life wind down at dusk.

D5 Can Tho

Rise early for the famous Cai Rang floating market, best seen at sunrise when trading is in full swing. Spend the rest of the day visiting tropical fruit orchards and a garden homestay for lunch.

**D6 Phu Quoc**

Fly to Phu Quoc and catch the island's famous indigo sunset at Sailing Club on Long Beach, from the rooftop at INK 360, or right from your resort deck.

D7 Phu Quoc

A full last day on the island. Spend it island-hopping and snorkelling around the An Thoi Archipelago, or head to one of Phu Quoc's theme parks for a fun-filled finale before flying home.
