01 Sapa

Ethnic minorities have lived on and cultivated Sapa's terraced slopes for centuries. The breathtaking mountains and valleys of this region always cast a spell on nature lovers.

02 Can Tho

Mekong Delta life is on full display in this colourful riverfront town. Sleep in a garden homestay, ride sampans through lush canals, and taste the Delta's sweet tropical fruits.

03 Con Dao

Most of this remote island is covered by thick forest, but its edges are trimmed with long stretches of white sand. Ride the breezy coastal roads to pristine beaches or go snorkelling off the coast.

DAY BY DAY

D1 Sapa

Travel from Hanoi to Sapa and settle into a mountain lodge surrounded by terraced valleys. Spend the evening unwinding and acclimatising to the cool highland air before tomorrow's trek.



D2 Sapa

Set out on foot through the rice terraces and past cascading waterfalls, passing through minority villages along the way. Stay the night with a local family for an authentic glimpse of highland life.

D3 Can Tho

Return to Hanoi and fly to Can Tho, gateway to the Mekong Delta. Just minutes outside the city, charming riverside hotels sit right on the water's edge, a perfect base for exploring the Delta.



D4 Can Tho

Take a boat out to tour the floating markets and surrounding islets. Sampan through narrow canals shaded by banana palms, visit a tropical fruit orchard, and try hu tieu noodle soup at the market.

D5 Con Dao

Transfer to Con Dao for a laidback beach break. This remote island sits two hours by sea from the mainland and rewards those who make the trip with near-empty beaches and crystal-clear water.



D6 Con Dao

A final day to snorkel, swim, and unwind on pristine beaches. Alternatively, ride bicycles along the coast to visit Con Dao's historic prison museums and wander the island's quiet, tree-shaded streets.

FULL ROUTE

Hanoi → Sapa → Can Tho → Con Dao

Be sure to try hu tieu, the Mekong Delta's signature noodle soup, at the floating market in Can Tho.
